

International Meisterakademie in Chamber Music 2024

Enjoying music at the highest level - This is the credo of the Konz Musik Festival, based in the picturesque 'Grande Région' of Germany, Luxembourg. France and Belgium.

Continuing the 30 year old tradition of the former summer academy, the International Meisterakademie in Chamber Music will take place from the 29th of August - 8th of September 2024, within the context of the Konz Musik Festival

The young talented musicians and groups chosen to participate in the academy will perform in concerts, an integral part of the official festival program on the 5th, 6th and 7th of September 2024. The academy participants will not only perform and study intensively with world renowned musicians, including masterclasses with the Barbican String Quartet and Joseph Moog, piano, but will also make invaluable lifelong contacts in the inspiring atmosphere that is the Konz Musik Festival.

The Meisterakademie in Chamber Music will be held at the Konz City Library. The famous architect Egon Eiermann of the industrial planning company in Essen designed this building in 1969 for the administrative purposes of the Zettelmeyer company, now Volvo AG. Constructed by Strabag-Bau AG, the City Library was completed in 1970 using industrially prefabricated materials.

The façades were specially adorned by the well known artist Georg Meistermann (1911-1990). This work of art is to this day regarded as a successful example in using colourful art as a dominant feature of urban design.

Applications

The International Meisterakademie in Chamber Music is now accepting applications from fixed ensembles as well as violin, viola, cello and piano. Fixed ensembles are invited to apply as a group.

Closing Date for applications is the 1st of August 2024.

Invited participants will receive solo and Chamber Music instruction and will be informed well inadvance about the repertoire that will need to be prepared prior to the academy.

During the Meisterakademie, rehearsals for the concerts 'Spotlight Junge Musiker' will take the form of publicly accessible masterclasses.

The academists will also have the opportunity and are highly encouraged to attend the concerts within the programme of the Konz Musik Festival.

Accommodation & Board

The participants are traditionally accommodated free of charge with selected and experienced host families.

Breakfast will be included. In addition, accommodation and breakfast in selected local hotels can be booked individually at the festival rate.

There will be a free, daily lunch as well as tea and coffee provided for all academy participants in the Building of the City Library of Konz.

If the Library is not within walking distance, a shuttle service will be provided by the festival. Transportation to and from all concert events will also be possible using the shuttle service.

Directions

The Library is located in Konz City and is easily accessible by train from the nearby cities of Trier and Saarbrücken.

The closest airports are the Luxembourg International Airport, the Saarbrücken International Airport and the Frankfurt Hahn International Airport.

The expected arrival day for participants of the festival will be the 29th of August 2024, with departure planned for the 8th of September 2024.
