



The more we know Salieri, the more we are surprised and respectful for his greatness as a composer. The more we admire him, the more we feel the unfairness of people 's misunderstanding and misjudgments towards him.


That is why we establish a new music festival "Salieri & Mozart". Here we will present the "Vienna School" based on 4 names: HAYDN – SALIERI – MOZART – BEETHOVEN.

If you know how important Salieri was as a teacher of Mozart´s son Franz Xaver, Mozart´s student Süssmayer, of Ludwig van Beethoven, Franz Schubert, and even Liszt and Meyerbeer, and how important he was for Vienna´s music life, as a president of several institutions and establishing the conservatory of the Music Society in Vienna, (today "mdw"), you will understand why we strongly believe that he is a fundamental part of the "Wiener Schule".

This year we are focusing on the music by "Salieri & Mozart" in 3 categories:

- I. for conductors:

 Masterclass and 3 final concerts
- II. for instrumental soloists:Masterclass, Competition and Final concert
- III. for opera singers:Masterclass, Competition and Gala concert



All concerts are played by the Joseph Haydn Symphony Orchestra Vienna.
